

# Download J.A. Froudes Mary Tudor

J.A. Froude was one of the finest English literary stylists of the Victorian age. But he was highly critical of Mary Tudor, whose reign he viewed as something of a disaster. Eamon Duffy takes a very different view and so this book will spark off even more controversy about this most maligned of queens. J.A. Froude wrote this in the 19th century, which is good to know before reading it. Eamon Duffy's introduction is also helpful. This is the work of a man who saw the unhappy queen in Freudian terms-- the word 'hysterical' comes up often. J. A.
