Kathleen Mansfield Murry (née Beauchamp; 14 October 1888 – 9 January 1923) was a prominent New Zealand modernist short-story writer and poet who was born and brought up in colonial New Zealand and wrote under the pen name of Katherine Mansfield. The Katherine Mansfield Society is an International Trust set up to promote and encourage enjoyment of Katherine Mansfield's writing. New Zealand's greatest writer will have a journal, conference and newsletter in her name. This is a listing of the stories by author with mention of the books that the stories were taken from or mention of the person who so graciously supplied the story to Classic Short Stories. A Dill Pickle is a 1917 short story by Katherine Mansfield. It was first published in the New Age on 4 October 1917. A revised version later appeared in Bliss and Other Stories. The characters and their relationship were possibly inspired by Mansfield's older sister Vera Margaret Beauchamp and her husband James Mackintosh Bell., Katherine Mansfield - The Short Stories - Volume 2.
