Pansori (Hangul: 판소리) is a Korean genre of musical storytelling performed by a singer and a drummer. In music, Gugwangdae describes a long story that takes about three hours for short and six hours for a long time. Korean literature is the body of literature produced by Koreans, mostly in the Korean language and sometimes in Classical Chinese. For much of Korea's 1,500 years of literary history, it was written in Hanja. Korean traditional music: singing the joy and sorrow of the Korean people. Korean traditional or folk music (called "gukak" in Korean) has been passed down through the generations since antiquity. Gukak has many distinct traits, from the most basic elements of the music to its tone and format.
