

# Download Oquita V. Industrial Commission

The Industrial Commission originally granted that request, finding a compensable loss of earning capacity. Upon the respondent's timely request for hearing, however, the matter went to hearings. On the basis of an extensive record, the hearing officer entered an award, affirmed on review, finding that petitioner was not entitled to any benefits. This petition for review followed. OQUITA v.
