Methods. We estimated maternal mortality at the global, regional, and national levels from 1990 to 2015 for ages 10–54 years by systematically compiling and processing all available data sources from 186 of 195 countries and territories, 11 of which were analysed at the subnational level. Violence is "the use of physical force so as to injure, abuse, damage, or destroy." Less conventional definitions are also used, such as the World Health Organization's definition of violence as "the intentional use of physical force or power, threatened or actual, against oneself, another person, or against a group or community, which either ...Evidence before this study. The Global Burden of Diseases, Injuries, and Risk Factors Study (GBD) produces the only assessment of prevalence, incidence, and years lived with disability (YLDs) for a comprehensive list of diseases and injuries, and for all countries from 1990 to the present.
