To understand America's actions during the Cold War, it is essential to understand NSC 68 — the 1950 report, requested by President Truman and prepared by the National Security Council (NSC), that guided American foreign policy for nearly forty years. When Kennedy ran for president in 1960, one of his key election issues was an alleged "missile gap" with the Soviets leading.
