Mike Horse Mining & Milling Co. (1947), 120 Mont. 1, 8, 180 P.2d 252, 256; Hoffman v. Roehl (1921), 61 Mont. 290, 298-99, 203 P. 349, 350. In this case, it is undisputed that Bacon was not acting on behalf of the ranch company or the cattle company at the time that his conduct caused Barbara's injury.
